Items that can be placed in recycling containers:

- Glass bottles/jars (all colors)
- Cardboard
- Mixed papers
- Junk mail/magazines
- Newspapers
- Plastic bottles/jars (CRV# 1 & 2)
- Plastic milk containers
- Metal cans
- Plastic beverage bottles (CRV# 1-7)
- Frozen food boxes
- Cereal boxes (with plastic liner removed)
- Empty paper towel and bath tissue rolls

Items that should **NOT** be placed in recycling containers:

- Paper towels and tissues
- Plates and napkins
- Styrofoam
- Plastic/paper cups
- Aluminum foil
- Pizza boxes
- Cardboard milk containers
