"Customers who usually receive service on Thursday will instead receive it Friday, and Friday's customers will receive service on Saturday," said David Ross, director, public sector services. "We appreciate our customers' cooperation with the holiday schedule so that all of our employees can observe Thanksgiving."

All Waste Management of Orange County operations will be closed, including transfer stations in Irvine and Orange, on Thursday, November 25, with normal operations resuming on Friday, November 26.
